

Omega Track Classes (subject to availability of teachers): *This is a tentative list of classes. An updated list will be available on the web site.* (Maximum class size indicated after each class offering.)

Auditioned Handbells - Auditions on Monday afternoon. (Class will be made up from audition results on Monday afternoon and evening.)

Auditioned Vocal Ensemble - Auditions on Monday afternoon. (Class will be made up from audition results on Monday afternoon and evening.)

Banners – (15) Learning how to make church banners. Making banners interpreting the Christian life. \$5.00 fee for materials.

Guitar I - (15) Bring your own guitar. For those with little or no guitar experience.

Guitar II – (15) Bring your own guitar. For those with basic knowledge and play some. For those who can play basic chords (i.e., c, d, g, a).

Handbells – (25) (Level determined by experience - fill out information below)

Interpretive Movement – (28) Christian songs and/or camp music are interpreted through movement. Designed for those just beginning or for those with experience.

Introduction to Piano – (10) Learning the basics of piano using electric keyboards.

LOL- (Lots of Lyrics) – (15) Children will use their creative and improvising skills to write a musical composition suitable for worship. Using a psalm or other biblical text, each class will select a text, write melodies, and write their own song or poem.

Make It/Give It - Make gifts to share with those less fortunate than ourselves. \$10.00 fee

Orchestra/Band – Must have completed equivalent of one full school year of band or orchestra class. String players must be able to play in first position on all four strings. Bring your own instrument. Mark all personal items with your name, church and address. Remember to bring extra reeds, strings, etc.

Piano Level II – (10) (Must have completed Level 2 piano and above.) Playing duets, trios, and in groups.

Puppets – Basic puppet manipulation. Making props and puppet choreography.

Scapes (Visual Arts) – (15) Visual arts are an important aspect of worship and the expression of one's faith. Since the days when early persecuted Christians carved the fish symbol into walls, art has been identified with Christianity. Come explore some of the history and beauty of religious art, while completing your own "masterpiece" expressing your faith and worship. \$5.00 fee for materials.

Stomp – Finding rhythm and expression in everyday objects through percussion techniques.

Voice Class – (10) Learn how to better use your voice in praise to God.

World Drumming – (15) Explore drums and rhythms. Drums and instruments are provided.
