CORPORATE WORSHIP STRATEGY Opportunities for believers to experience the presence and power of God and for unbelievers to hear the gospel and see its power demonstrated in the lives of believers.	MINISTRY TEAMS STRATEGY Opportunities for believers to serve the church and be involved in missions.
